- Apex ETJ request
 - Apex is removing New Hill and Bonsal from ETJ request. Amendment approved at Apex Town Council meeting January 16 due to both areas are within 5 mile radius of Shearon Harris Plant.
- New Hill Slogan contest. Mimi Kelly has posted 18 candidates to our web site. NHCA Board will narrow down candidates and ask community to vote to determine a winner
- Guy Meilleur is working with Cathy Heath on a beautification design for the New Hill Exits. Once design is approved, Guy will schedule a workday to help with the project. Guy projects end of February. Also, Rev. Clanton mentioned that Marty Clayton (PE Community Relations) expressed interest in joining the project

New and Future Business

- Wake County School Board is looking to build a new high school and middle school on Humie Olive Rd. Property is \$8.7M for 108 acres
- Discussed the recent Apex Informational meeting held at New Hill Fire Station. Meeting explained about water and electric easements on Old US 1 coming from Holland Rd (Friendship) and continuing down New Hill – Holleman Rd to New Hill Fire Station (water line only). Electric line is a future project and will run on opposite side of the road from water line. Electric is for future development in the area. Apex is a competitor to PE.
