- Proposed name for New Hill organization – New Hill Community Association
- Website – might want to create and register our own named site. Would cost money for the DNS. Bill Ott would help setup the website

 - Committees to meet before Monday’s Town meeting
 - Facilitator for meeting (Paul Barth – create agenda)

 - Owner needs to file injunction after notice of condemnation
 - New Hill could join in the injunction
 - Attorney fees projected to be \$200 / hr plus misc. administration costs – includes court time
 - Stated that we need a political resolution
 - Agreed that an organizational body will carry more weight politically than individual people
